In the men's championship we need 4 runners to count for the team. For the women 3 are needed to count. The team must complete 4 races out of the 6. One must be at each distance (short, medium, long). The fourth can be our best other result. It probably is best to aim to get strong teams to all six of the championships because injury or illness at the last moment can often scupper the very best laid plans. Are you up for it?
